Alliance Facility Guidelines

- 1. TandemEDU is a home school co-op offering students the opportunity to take high school and college classes at a host facility. TandemEDU is not a school and does not receive grants, gifts, bequeathments or other donations which are tax deductible to the donor, therefore, TandemEDU is not a 501(c)(3) organization.
- 2. The facility must have a TandemEDU host/hostess in place. The host/hostess will carry out the responsibilities listed in the Hostess Role Description.
- 3. The alliance will need two classrooms the first year, then add a classroom every year (one per tier) for a maximum of 5-6 classrooms. Each classroom will need to seat a maximum of 15 students with tables. A common area for students to eat lunch and fellowship is also requested.
- 4. Classrooms will be used one day per week from 8:00 am to 2:30 pm. Setup will begin at 7:30 am by the alliance hostess. Cleanup will conclude by 3:00 pm.
- 5. Classes will run for 32 weeks. Classes will begin the 4th week in August and conclude the 2nd week in May.
- 6. Classes run on a quarterly basis. There is a five to six week break during December and January.
- 7. TandemEDU will provide proof of liability insurance which names the host facility as an additional insured.
- 8. TandemEDU can pay rent monthly as agreed upon with the facility.
- 9. The TandemEDU students will undertake at least one service project for the host facility during the school year
- 10. TandemEDU will provide the program calendar to the facility in May for the next academic year.
- 11. TandemEDU will be responsible for all cleanup necessary to return the facility to a condition better than when the host/hostess arrived.
- 12. TandemEDU will provide any whiteboards as necessary for the classrooms.
- 13. We ask the host facility to provide access to reliable 6 Mb internet for teacher/facilitator use. TandemEDU will provide laptops and projectors.
- 14. TandemEDU will need a secure location at the facility where TandemEDU equipment, books, materials, etc. can be stored. This can be either a stand-alone locked cabinet which measures 35"wide x 71" tall x 18" deep (purchased by TandemEDU) or a locked closet or room within the facility.
- 15. Facility exterior access doors will be locked while classes are meeting. TandemEDU will purchase and install a Ring doorbell at an entry door designated by the facility.
